## Identifying Academic Needs

<b>Impacted Students:</b>	<i>How will schools/districts identify which students have been most impacted by the pandemic in terms of their learning progress (with a focus on the most vulnerable student populations including but not limited to disengaged students)?</i>	
	<p>Kids Care Elementary (KCE) will use grade level benchmarks from NWEA to determine the students who have been negatively impacted. KCE will use multiple measures, such as formative assessments that are aligned to learning standards, grade levels, subjects, teacher referral based on academic performance, data from classroom, results of state tests (OELPA, OST, KRA) and etc. For 2022-2023 school year, we will reflect on the data collected from the 2021-2022 school year, including teacher and student feedback to continue the practices that were successful and make needed changes as we move forward. We'll be especially mindful of our students who have an IEP or 504 plan, are among our EL population, or whose attendance has been a challenge since the pandemic began.</p>

	<p>KCE will provide summer school to students in grades K-5. School times will be from 8:30-2:30pm which is an extension of our usual summer school day. Summer school will run for a period of 18 school days and will focus on reading, math and experiences like art, gym and STEM to address the learning</p>

Additionally, our teachers will provide after school tutoring for students in need. As with any extended learning program, if transportation is a barrier, the school will make an effort to address that need.</p>

These measures may include data from collaboration with parents, teacher records, and/or data from the school psychologist. As with addressing academic concerns, KCE uses the MTSS (Multi-Tiered System of Supports) to address social and emotional needs of students.</p>

	<p>A full time on-site Social Worker provides access to therapy services through a partnership with Eastway Corporation. During breaks from school, the therapist is able to make home visits or to utilize tele-health options (Zoom) to accomplish sessions if transportation is a barrier. KCE has also reached out to the Handle with Care program to explore the possibility of implementation in our learning community. This would assist staff of students who may have experienced a recent occurrence that may negatively impact their education.</p>
